Responsibilities

- Find, coordinate, and communicate new projects to bid on.
- Review projects in advance to determine the significance of the bid and allocate enough time for an effective bid.
- Attend pre-bid meetings.
- Review updated plans and addendums.
- Review Geotech reports; correlate the Geotech reports with design intent of the drawings. What deep foundation system is best for these loads and ground conditions? How does MDFE separate and stand out among others? Build the project in your head and translate it into an easy-to-follow outline during bidding.
- Write and present thorough proposals to bidders.
- Follow up on proposals with GC's.
- Build and maintain a relationship with GC's and developers to get the last look at projects.
- Provide GMP level budgets to developers/general contractors for future projects.
- Estimating hand off meetings for awarded projects to the project management team.
- Assist the project manager, (if needed) for plan submittals.
- Create, review, and finalize, (with VP of Estimating) engineering plans and calculations for projects designed in-house and prepare for stamping.
- Prepare plans and installation records for the crew in the field.
- Attending and contributing to lunch and learn presentations.
- Assist in Business Development.
